

2021-2023 Biomass Tax Credit

CERTIFICATE OF EFFICIENCY

Applicable systems, whether they are stoves purchased to heat space or larger, whole-home heating systems, will now qualify for a renewable energy investment tax credit (Section 25(D) of the Internal Revenue Code). Beginning in 2021, consumers buying highly efficient wood or pellet stoves will be able to claim a 26% tax credit. The credit will remain at 26% through 2021 and 2022, and then increase to 30% (with a max of \$2,000) in 2023. This provision applies to residential biomass heating equipment that are at least 75% efficient and purchased before December 31st, 2023. Please refer to the HPBA website for further information.
